This week I would like to highlight Voice-to-Text and other reading and writing supports available using Chrome extensions like Co-Writer, Snap & Read, and Kami. Many jobs require tools in order to complete tasks efficiently. We encourage students to think of their accommodations as simply tools in their toolbox for success! If your child struggles with an online assignment, remind them to use what they already have in their toolbox, built right into their Chromebook!
