Learning Ally may be used as an accommodation. All students are asked to read for 15-20 minutes and write a summary four days per week. Parents, we are asking you to sign the reading log daily. If the reading and summary are completed at school under the direction of a teacher. The teacher will sign the form. Together our goal is to read 25,000 minutes. We are well on our way to meeting this goal.
